MEANWHILE USE PROJECT UPDATE

Thank you to everyone for their feedback on the refurbishment of the former Tenant Management Organisation (TMO) Hall. We are now working with an architect on how to make it happen. We want to know what you think and will be in touch with exciting plans very shortly!

In the meantime, we are pleased that the Multi-Use Games Area near Dennison and basketball court near Lund have had a makeover. Brightly coloured designs by local young people are now beaming on both courts. Benches which have also been designed by local young residents have been installed outside The Dovetail!

The 5th September marked a significant milestone in the progression of the regeneration of the Carpenters with Newham Council approving £36.5m to enable detailed design for new homes as part of Phases 2 (Lund Quarter), Phases 3 (Station Quarter), commercial offer and a new building for Carpenters Primary School.

As well as a series of meanwhile projects to enliven the estate for the benefit of existing residents and the wider community in Stratford and beyond. This much anticipated approval will pave the way for the next phases of work to commence.


MASTERPLAN UPDATE DROP IN SESSION

The vision for the future Carpenters Primary School is to deliver a sustainable and state-of -the -art school for Carpenters children now and for the future. Consultation sessions have been completed with the school, pupils and parents to help decide what are the key 'ingredients' for a better school.

The Approval of cabinet will allow for more detailed work to be completed to finalise design concepts.

KNOW YOUR NEIGHBOURHOOD

The Carpenters Estate hosted its first 'Know Your Neighbourhood' event lead by the London Legacy Development Corporation on the 27th September. Held at the Building Craft College, it was the perfect opportunity to bring community members, business and partners in and around Stratford together to see how we can work better together and share community spaces and increase opportunity for local jobs and skills.

RESIDENTS SPORTS DAY WITH WEST HAM UNITED **FOUNDATION**

Populo Living and the West Ham United Foundation teamed up for a free multisports day, welcoming residents of all ages and skill levels. Young residents enjoyed the inaugural sports day at the multi-use games area, guided by coaches from the foundation. The activities included dribbling drills, football tennis, footwork practice, and ended with an exciting match between two teams.



YOUNG DESIGNERS GROUP

From August 22nd to 25th, 20 young people participated in the Young Designers Group programme at The Dovetail, focusing on the 'Future of Work'. Impressive ideas were generated, including a diverse art business and a mental health and wellness hub for young people.

The programme featured a workshop, led by James Kaguima, a Carpenters resident and founder of Skate Cabal. This provided valuable insights into the world of business. The programme concluded with a 'Dragon's Den' style presentation, with the winning team earning tickets to the Sidemen charity football tournament at the London Stadium.

These sessions will be running until the end of November.



OPEN DOOR AT THE DOVETAIL

Over the summer we wanted to share the Dovetail space with residents and partners in and around Stratford and opened our doors in the evenings and over the weekend for community activity. We saw Afro Brazilian sessions bringing music, food and culture to the space and Social Ark Culture Exchange programme hosting their final session with us. Hive Curates also held the Black History Memory event.



STEERING GROUP UPDATES

We relaunched the Steering Group with Source Partnership and hosted an open meeting on 26 September. Non-members had the chance to share ideas and raise concerns about repairs, maintenance, and project scheduling. We also invited people to join the steering group.
