OUTLINE MASTERPLAN PLANNING APPLICATION HAS BEEN SUBMITTED

In August 2022, we submitted an outline planning application for the Carpenters Estate to LLDC. This is an exciting milestone for the project. It represents the culmination of all the effort and energy residents and the team have put into co-designing the Masterplan.

The application will be valid from 22nd September and available to view online.. Letters will be sent out to all residents informing them of how they can comment on the proposals via the official consultation process.

We will also be door knocking during the first week of October and will be sharing some further information on whats happening on the estate.

It will take some time for LLDC to review and decide on the planning application. Once we have received their decision we will set out a timeline for the next phases of work.


