

You decide the future of Carpenters! Before any decision is made about replacing homes on the Carpenters Estate, it's up to you to vote whether the project can go ahead. This is called the Ballot process and currently we expect this will take place in late Spring 2021.



A message from your Ward Councillors



As 2020 draws to a close it's hard to believe quite how long this difficult year has felt, all the while appearing to have flown by.

We have been consistently impressed by the passion of residents and Populo's commitment to continue remote engagement through the Autumn. This week a dedicated Community Liaison Officer will start on the estate and become one of your main points of contact for issues, ideas and suggestions to maintain the legacy of Carpenters whilst building the homes and community infrastructure we need. The Boundary Commission has finalised its recommendations for redrawing Newham's electoral wards. Carpenters Estate will continue to be represented by a team of three Stratford councillors after the 2022 local elections. Until then, the three of us will continue to speak up for the whole of Stratford and New Town on the Council and respond to your needs. In November, Newham Council marked Islamophobia Awareness Month with a series of events aimed at tackling hate and discrimination against our borough's Muslim communities. Newham's diversity is our strength. We will continue to champion all of our residents and wish you a safe, happy and healthy festive season with your close families. Best wishes,




